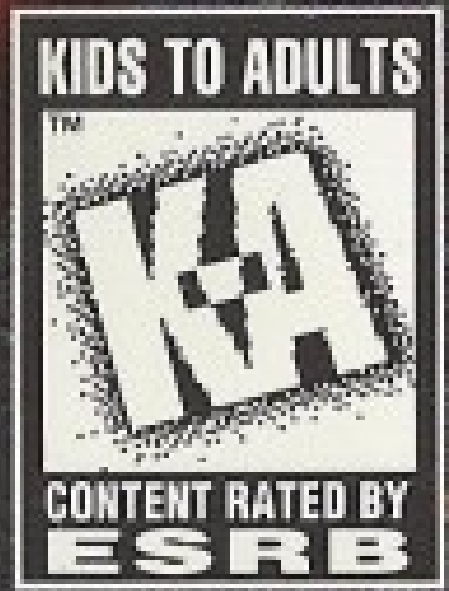

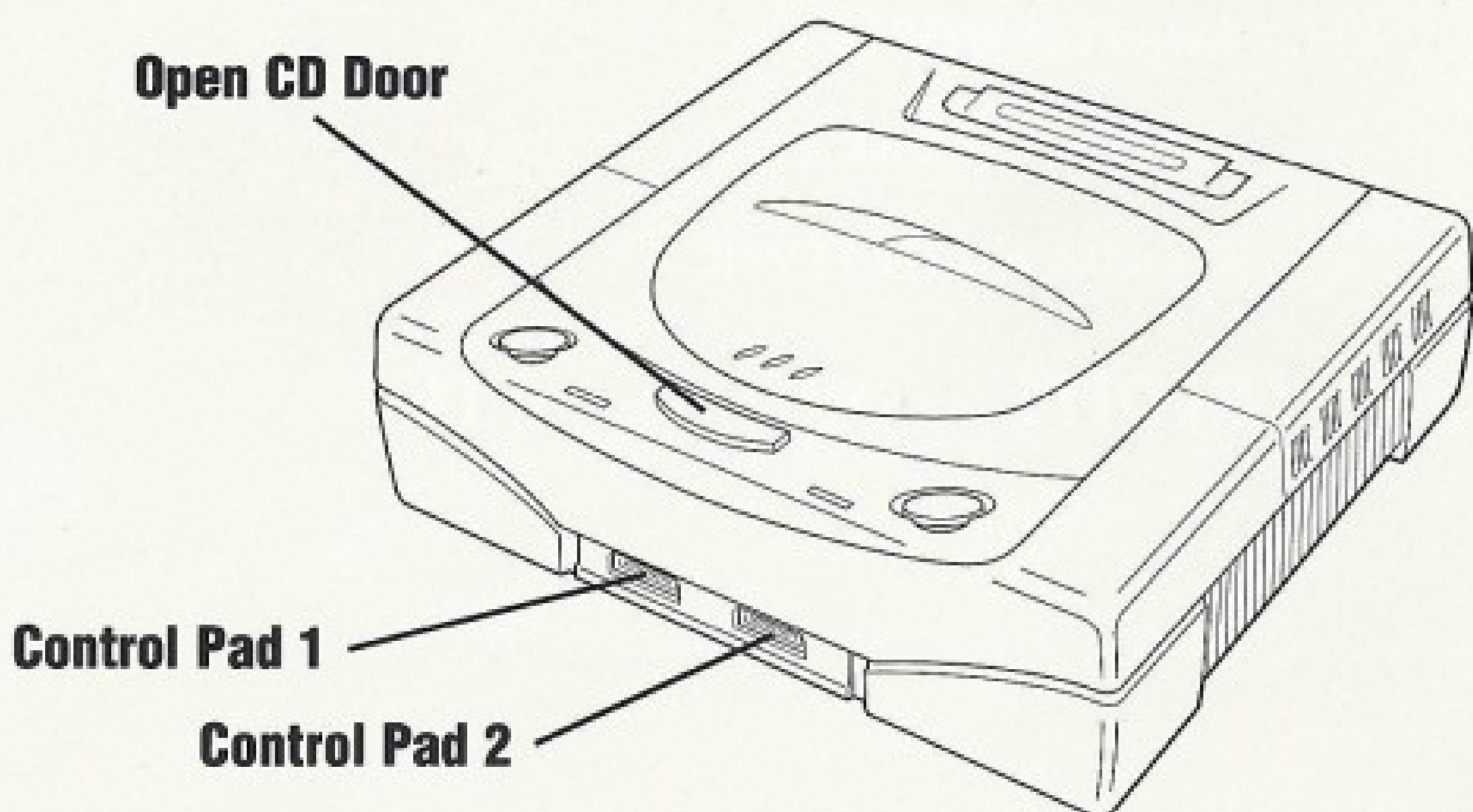

GETTING STARTED

1. Set up your Sega Saturn Systemx as described in its instruction manual.
2. Place Disk 1 **BUG TOO!**, label side up, in the well of the CD tray and close the lid.
3. Turn on the TV or monitor and the Sega Saturn. The Sega Saturn logo will appear on screen. If nothing appears, turn the system off and make sure it is set up correctly before turning it on again.
4. If you wish to stop a game in progress, or the game ends, open the CD drive door, or perform a soft reset during the Title Loop to reach the CD Control Panel.

Important: Your Sega Saturn CD contains a security code that allows the disc to be read. Be sure to keep the disc clean and handle it carefully. If your Sega Saturn system has trouble reading the disc, remove the disc and wipe it carefully, starting from the center of the disc and wiping straight out toward the edge.

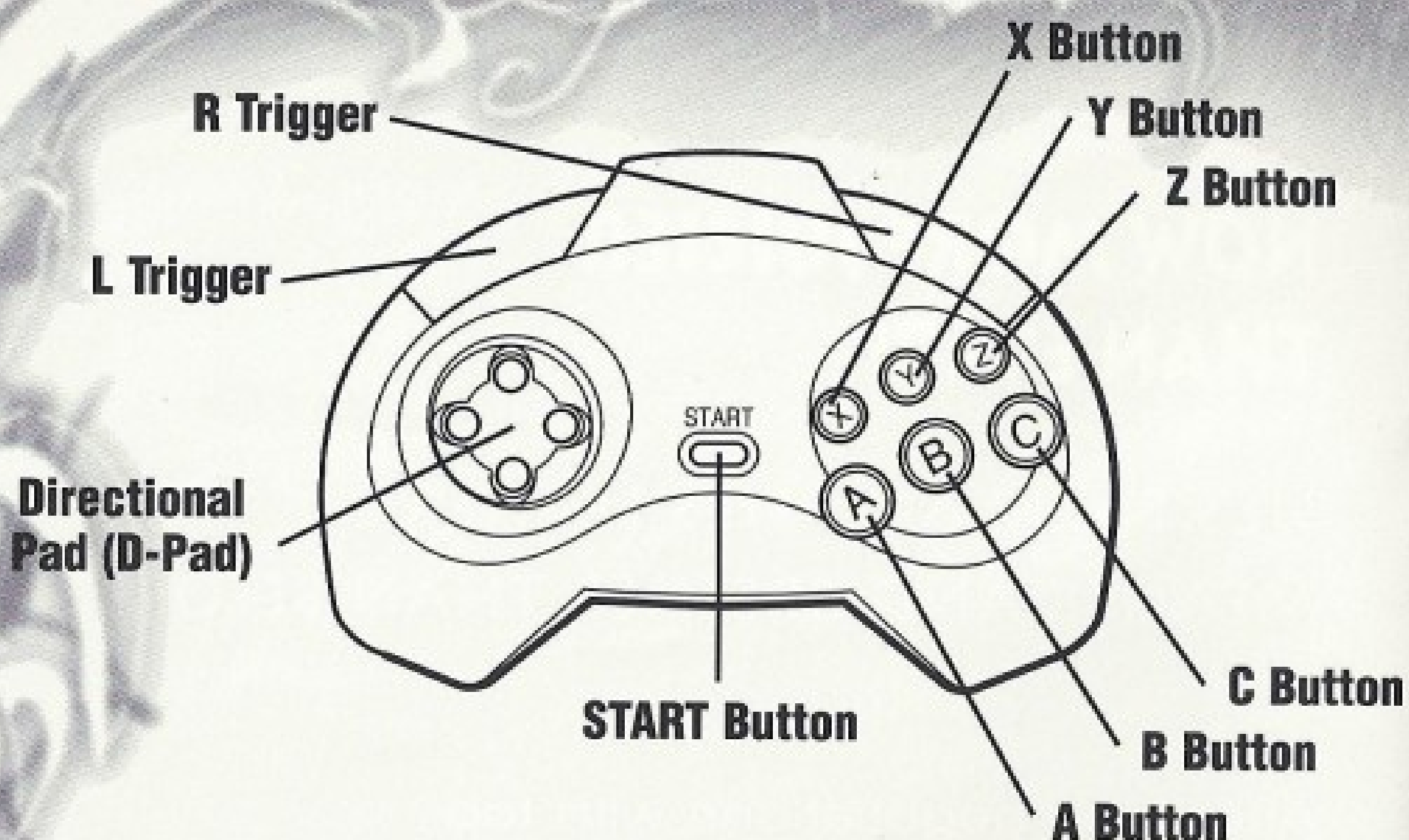

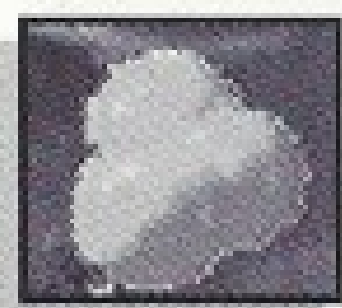
If you want to turn the music and sound on or off, as well as configure the D-Pad, you can do that in this menu.

BUG POWER-UPS

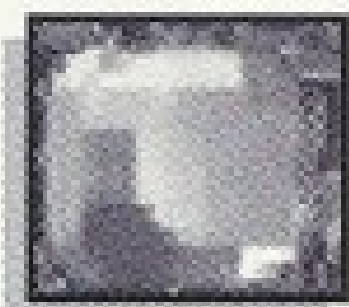
Throughout each level you can collect Power-Ups to replenish your Bug Juice.



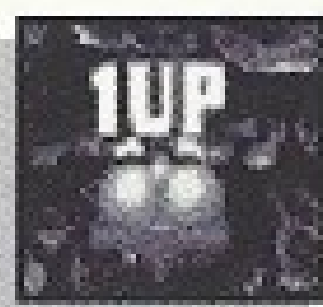
Bug Juice: Collect to replenish your Bug Juice to full capacity.



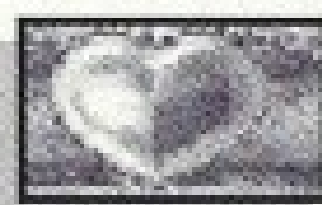
Spit Glob: Gives you an unlimited supply of phlegm to shoot.



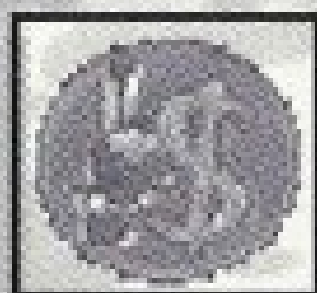
Sugar Crystals, Doggie Bones and Disco Balls: Award you with big, juicy points.

Hearts: Replenishes your Bug Juice just a tad.

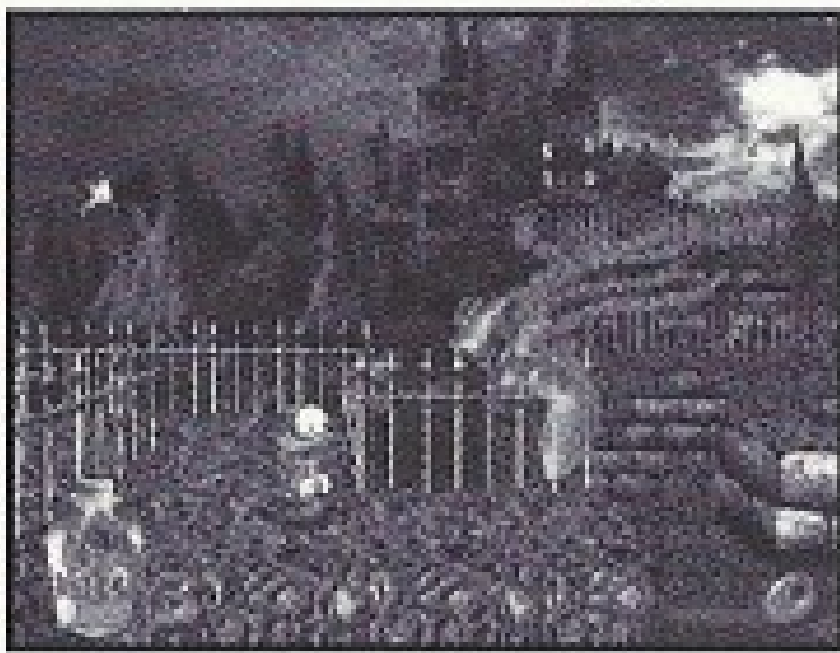
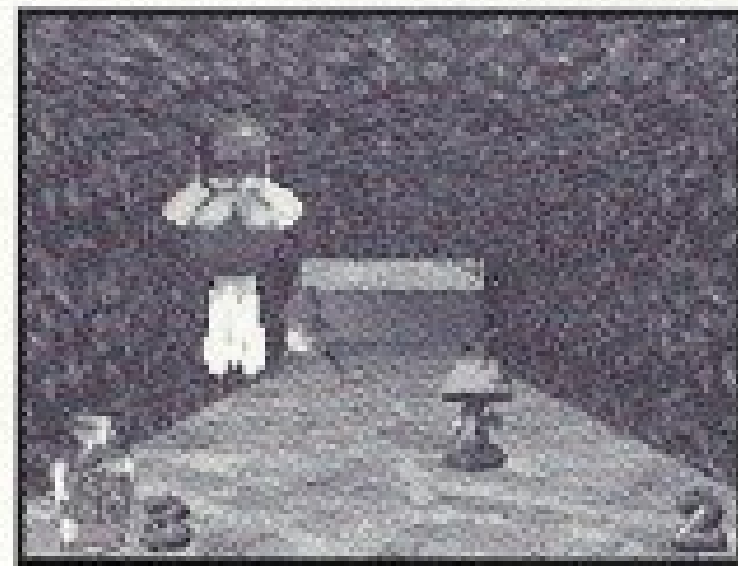
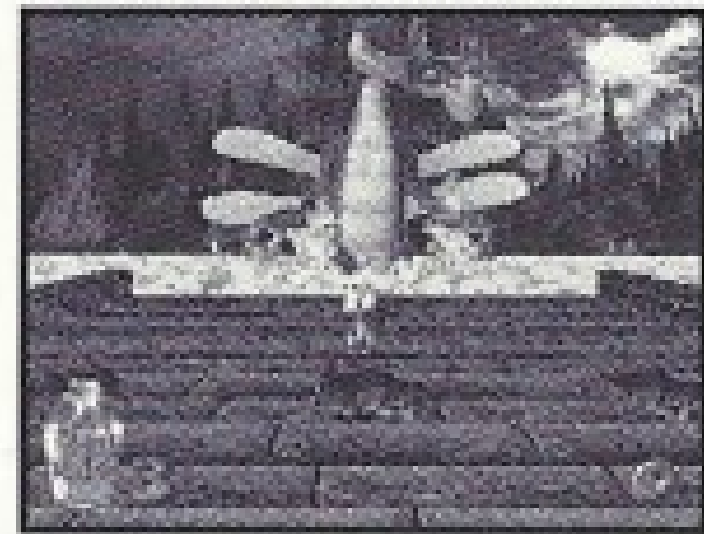

BugSuckers: Yikes! Armored Rolly Pollys, Mosquito Vampires and Reapers! Run, run, run!



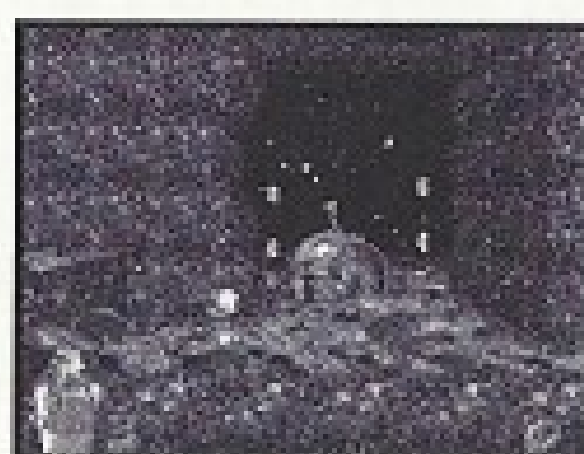
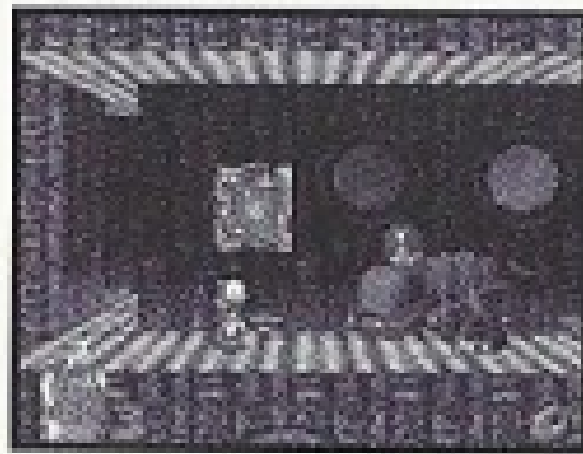
SWATTERWORLD

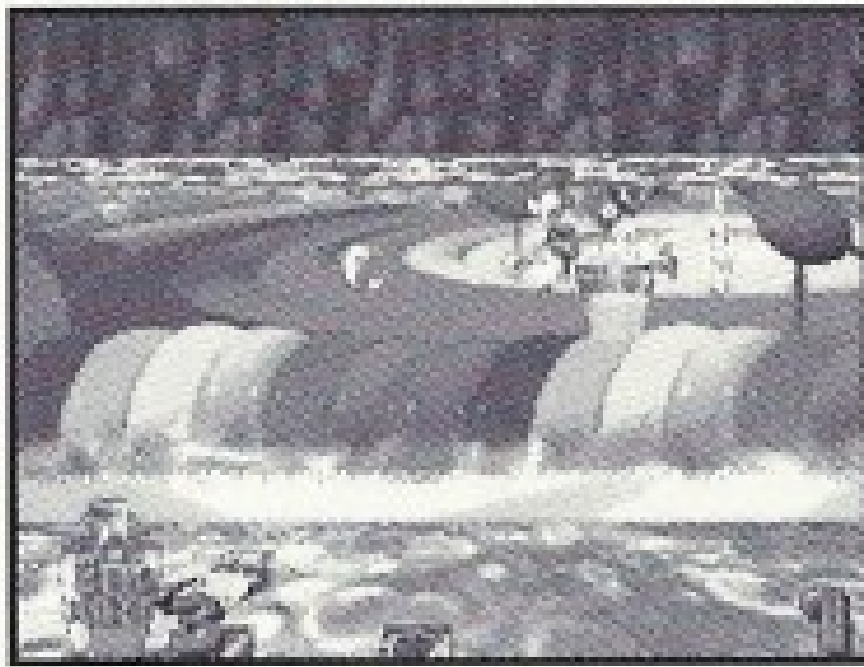

LIMITED WARRANTY

Sega of America, Inc. warrants to the original consumer purchaser that the Sega Saturn compact disc shall be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of 90 days from the date of purchase. If a defect covered by this limited warranty occurs during this 90-day warranty period, Sega will repair or replace the defective compact disc at its option, free of charge. This limited warranty does not apply if the defects have been caused by negligence, accident, unreasonable use, modification, tampering or any other causes not related to defective materials or workmanship.

The cost of returning the disc to Sega's Service Center shall be paid by the purchaser.

REPAIRS AFTER EXPIRATION OF WARRANTY

If your Sega Saturn compact disc requires repairs after termination of the 90-day limited warranty period, you may contact the Sega Consumer Service Department at the number listed above.
